An organised **Remembrance Sunday** gathering at the War Memorial would have limited access points, details taken for Test and Protect and strict stewarding of 2m physical distancing. No such gathering will be held and we are advising visits to the War Memorial in your own time during the period of Remembrance to pause and lay wreaths or poppies.

The Last Post will be played from the church bell tower just before 11am on Sunday 8th and Wednesday 11th. The Church service at 10:00am on the 8th will mark Remembrance with a 2 minute Silence. Poppies are available from the Blackford Stores.

Santa's Crafty Fun Run/Walk will be over the weekend of 5/6 December. Similar to the Blackford 500 in June, there will be stalls along the route selling the wares of our amazing village crafters and artists (£5 donation from stallholders.) More info to follow.
